



Pathologist Position Molecular Oncology Group

A pathologist position is available at the Molecular Oncology Laboratory to work on the project “*Estudio de fase Ib/II, abierto, multicéntrico de HDM201 por vía oral en combinación con LEE011 por vía oral en pacientes adultos con liposarcoma*”. The group has a long tradition in studying and testing hypothesis-based targeted therapy in oncology.

Specifically, the candidate will be involved in multiple clinical trials in which the lab acts as central or local laboratory. He/She will also be collaborating with our basic and translational researchers in projects involving the understanding of basic cancer biology as well as mechanism of action and resistance of targeted therapies.

Requirements:

We are seeking for a Research-oriented pathologist able to work in cross-cultural teams. Experience in working in similar position and under ISO15189 or CLIA/CAP quality Systems will be positively considered. Fluency in English is mandatory.

Tasks:

- Develop, validate and implement novel tissue-based assays (Immunohistochemistry, Fluorescent in situ hybridization, etc)
- Evaluate, interpret and analyze molecular diagnostic biomarkers in clinical trials, enabling pharmacodynamics monitoring and dose finding, disease monitoring and patient stratification and selection
- Coordinate internal and external research collaborative projects
- Provide guidance and pathology expertise to basic, translational and clinical research teams
- Participate to site initiation visit in clinical trials open at Vall d’Hebron
- Write and revise laboratory standard operating procedures
- Supervise the work of technical staff
- Generate publication
