The project assesses the coping strategies of patients with chronic pain in front of different situations where pain can cause interference with functioning. The research technician will analyze the data from the study using SPSS and MPlus as statistical packages. The research technician will then prepare a report of the results with the Pain Clinic team.

In a second phase, the research technician, along with the Pain Unit team, will design the second part of the project, which will consist of a psychoeducational program focused on pain coping. This program will be implemented by the research technician.
