JOB DESCRIPTION

Education and qualifications:

Required:

- Licensed nurse.

Experience and knowledge:

- English language: user knowledge.
- User knowledge of common software programmes.

Main responsibilities and duties:

The Clinical Research Nurse is a Registered Nurse (RN) who works collaboratively with physicians, Clinical Research Associates (CRA) and pharmacists to coordinate care for an assigned population of patients who are enrolled in clinical research trials.

- Assist in the assessment, management and coordination of care across the continuum of care.
- Educate patients and families on the clinical trial treatments and required testing.
- Responsible to assure that the documentation for the clinical trial is completed, and evaluation of processes to improve and advance clinical research are conducted.
- Trial tasks: identification of candidate subjects, trial procedures (skin tests, blood sample drawing, ECG, nasal provocation...), completion of CRD, administration of immunotherapy, etc.
- Participation in trial meetings (national or international).

Labour conditions:

- Contract: temporary for 6 months, extendible.
- Full Time: 40 hours per week.
- Gross annual salary: € 22,000.
