- Master in Translational Medical Research by the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB).
- Proven experience in protein immunodetection techniques (Western Blot, Elisa), tissue immunofluorescence, histochemical staining (hematoxylin-eosin, acridine orange...) extraction and amplification of nucleic acid (RT-PCR and qPCR), studies of transcriptional activity by luciferase.
