JOB DESCRIPTION

Education and qualifications:

Required:

- Bachelor in Biochemistry.
- Master's degree in Biomedicine.
- Certification as user of Laboratory Animals for Research (UAB or equivalent).

Experience and knowledge:

- Minimum of 2-year experience in molecular biology or biochemistry lab.
- Proven experience in mouse laboratory handling (drug administration, mouse lines management...) will be indispensable.
- Experience in mouse primary cell culturing will be required.
- Experience in HPLC or LC-MS/MS will be preferred.
- Experience with cloning and protein expression and purification will be preferred.

Main responsibilities and duties:

- Optimization of drug administration pattern for pre-clinical assays in mitochondria disease mouse models. This includes:
 - Mouse tissue sampling for different downstream approaches.
 - Drugs and related metabolites determination by LC-MS/MS.
- Assessment of mitochondrial function in cell and mouse models (Determination of mitochondrial DNA quality and quantity).
- Aid in recombinant protein expression and purification for in vitro assays.
