JOB DESCRIPTION

Education and qualifications:

Required:

- Bachelor's degree in Biology and/or Biochemistry
- Master's degree in Biomedicine

Experience and knowledge:

- Knowledge in cardiological studies
- Minimum 5 years of experience

Main responsibilities and duties:

- Isolation of differential cardiac mitochondrial subpopulations in murine and human tissue for biochemical and functional determinations (oximetry, absorbance and luminescence).
- Cell subfraction and quantification of the degree and location of terminally glycated proteins using ELISA and immunofluorescence
- Detection of molecular interaction between intracellular proteins using the Proximity Ligation Assay technique
- Enzymatic kinetics of the routes involved in the detoxification of precursors of advanced glycation products (AGEs).
