JOB DESCRIPTION

Education and qualifications:

Required: Degree or Grade in Life Sciences It will be valued to have a PhD degree

Required skills:

- Good communication skills and fluency in spoken and written English
- Strong sense of responsibility, organization, initiative and self-motivation.
- Social skills and ability to work as a team.

Experience and knowledge:

Prior experience on primer design and PCR optimization, Sanger sequencing, library preparation for NGS (especially in Illumina protocols) and the knowledge in bioinformatic tools for sequence analysis. It will be highly valued to have knowledge in the field of hematology and hemostasis.

Main responsabilities/duties:

The selected person will be incorporated into the work team of the congenital coagulopathies laboratory. The main duties will be to develop technical tasks of sequencing the clinical exomes and complete exomes, analyze the data obtained and do the variant prioritization, as well as to verify mutations by Sanger sequencing. It will also be responsible for managing the database and exploiting the results.
