JOB DESCRIPTION

Education and qualifications:

Required:

- Recent PhD degree (2015→)

Experience and knowledge:

- Training and/or experience in clinical and/or epidemiological research
- Training and/or experience in patients with stroke or neurovascular or cardiovascular pathology
- Training and/or experience in evaluation of the functional state or self-report quality of life through structured interview and standardized scales

Main responsibilities and duties:

- The candidate must carry out the coordination and execution of the field work of the telephone tracking of a cohort of patients who have had a stroke and have been hospitalized for thrombolytic and/or endovascular treatment in different hospitals of Catalonia.
- The follow-up will consist of a structured interview that will include the evaluation of the functional state (Rankin scale), the degree of dependence (Barthel scale), the quality of life related to health (EuroQoL scale) and the need for help at home
More specifically:
 - Coordinate and supervise the team of interviewers, keep track of calls and keep up to date the work schedule for each interviewer
 - Quality control of the data collected in the interviews
 - Contact, if necessary, with those responsible for the study in the centres where patients have been treated
 - Review, if necessary, of the clinical histories in the centre where patients have been treated
 - Availability to move to different hospitals in Catalonia
