Education and qualifications:

Required:

- Laboratory FP or higher

We require previous experience in:

- Handling of human biological samples
- Management of databases

Main responsibilities and duties:

- To process biological samples from multiple sclerosis patients (peripheral blood) in an ultra-sensitive single molecule enzyme-linked immunoarray (Simoa HD-1) in order to measure the blood levels of a panel of biomarkers.
