Education and qualifications:

Required:

- Nursing Diploma or degree
- Training in Good Clinical Practices.
- Essential English for reading, mastering database/spreadsheets, use of computer, internet and fax.

Experience and knowledge:

Required:

- Experience working in Intensive Care Unit
- Experience in the management and dynamics of clinical trials
- Knowledge and experience in the handling, processing, storage and shipment of biological samples
- Advance level of Office Tools
- Management of databases
- Coordination and organization skills
- Communication skills and ability to work in multidisciplinary team

Main responsibilities and duties:

- Carry out nursing activities on the context of clinical trials in accordance with the guidelines of Good Clinical Practice
