Education and qualifications:

- University degree in Health Sciences.
- Study coordination training and/or experience.

- Evidence of working in the respiratory field is also desirable.

Main responsibilities and duties:

• The post holder will be responsible for coordinating prospective observational studies and clinical trials in respiratory diseases. Job duties and tasks include: study patient's recruitment and scheduling, perform some specific protocol





procedures during patient's visits (spirometry, walking test, bioimpedance), data collection and electronic data entry, among others.

- The candidate will have the opportunity to conduct his/her PhD in the frame of an ongoing project that deals with physical activity interventions in patients with chronic respiratory diseases.
