Education and qualifications:

Required:

- Degree in health sciences (biology, pharmacy, biochemistry, veterinary medicine, etc.).
- Must be interested in basic research and want to do a doctoral thesis.

Experience and knowledge:

Required:

- Good academic record (essential average grade higher than 8.5).
- An official university master's degree leading to a doctorate.
- Good knowledge of English.
- It will be positively valued to possess the title of the "Training course for research personnel using experimental animals" or to accredit experience in working with experimental animals.

Main responsibilities and duties:

 Collaborate in the design of the experiments, their performance, as well as the subsequent statistical analysis and interpretation of the data, always with the support of its thesis director
