The pre-doctoral researcher will work in an interdisciplinary environment in the project entitled +AGIL: integrated care for frail older adults in the community funded by Ajuntament de Barcelona & Institut de Cultura de Barcelona.

### **Education and qualifications:**

#### Required:

- Degree in Health Sciences (Physiotherapy, Nursing, Medicine, Psychology)
- Dissertation on aspects of aging or physical activity, officially inscribed in a Doctoral program.
