JOB DESCRIPTION

Main responsibilities and duties:

The Clinical Research Nurse is a Registered Nurse (RN) who works collaboratively with physicians, Clinical Research Associates (CRA) and pharmacists to coordinate care for an assigned population of patients who are enrolled in to clinical research trials.

- Assist in the assessment, management and coordination of care across the continuum of care
- Educate patients and families on the clinical trial treatments and required testing.
- Responsible to assure that the documentation for the clinical trial is completed and evaluation of processes to improved and advance clinical research are conducted.
- Trial tasks: identification of candidate subjects, trial procedures (skin tests, blood sample drawing, ECG, nasal provocation...), completion of CRD, administration of treatments, etc.
- Participation in trial meetings (national or international)

Labour conditions:

- Full-time position: 40 hours per week
- Temporary for 6 months, extendible.
- Gross salary € 22,000 per annum.
