Required:

- Postdoctoral researchers of any nationality (must have obtained their doctoral degrees two to seven years prior to deadline for applications (between 07/10/2013 and 07/10/2018).
- Pre or Postdoctoral stay/s abroad (For RETAINING grants: carry out the research in a Spanish university or research centre, must have carried out predoctoral or postdoctoral research at non-Spanish research centres or universities, in the continuous or discontinuous manner for at least six months prior to the deadline for applications //For INCOMING grants: not have resided in Spain more than 12 months in the last three years)
- English proficiency
- Match the eligibility criteria for the RETAINING or the INCOMING modality of the call (see: https://fundacionlacaixa.org/es/becas-la-caixa-posdoctorado-junior-leader-retaining)
- Application deadline: 4 September 2020.
