Education and qualifications:

Required:

- Degree in Psychology with a specialty in neuropsychology (specific training or COP certification).

Experience and knowledge:

Required:

- Demonstrable 1-4 years of experience in conducting neuropsychological assessments in adult and/or geriatric population.
- Specific knowledge on dementia, cognitive impairment and diabetes.
- Oral and written communication in Catalan, Spanish and English.

Main responsibilities and duties:

- To perform neuropsychological and psychosocial assessments of patients.
- To collaborate on participant recruitment management.
- To fill and maintain project dataset from the site.
- To work collaboratively with a multidisciplinary team in the revision and elaboration of RECOGNISED research materials.
