- Experience with care of patients with cardiac disease, specifically in the care of patients with heart failure.
- Experience with telemonitoring will be valued.
- Experience with patients and family self-care education will be valued.

Main responsibilities and duties:

- The candidate will integrate the role of a case manager in the process of in-hospital care and the transition to discharge of patients with HF.
- The objectives of this case manager include
- Identify patients who have been admitted to hospital with the diagnosis of heart failure.
- Establish a structured discharge follow-up with special emphasis on the vulnerable post-discharge phase
- Provide health education to patients prior to discharge
- Incorporate telemedicine in the follow-up of patients with HF. The candidate will inform and train the patients in the use of an app for patients with heart failure.
