Main responsibilities and duties:

This clinical research nurse will work collaboratively with physicians and Clinical Research Associates (CRA) to coordinate care for an assigned population of patients who will be enrolled in clinical research in the context of one National funded project.

- Study tasks: identification of candidate subjects, study procedures (blood sample drawing, anthropometric measurements), completion of CRD etc.
- Responsible to assure that the documentation for the study is completed, and evaluation of processes to improve and advance clinical research are conducted.
- Participation in study meetings (center).
- Assist in the assessment, management and coordination of care across the continuum of care.
