- The candidate has to possess a PhD in biosciences.
- The candidate has to have scientific background in the areas of infectious diseases or immunology.
- High motivation, independent and team work abilities.
- At least one publication as first author.

Preferred:

- Experience with human tissue samples and mucosal immunology.
- Experience in flow cytometry and data analyses, including FlowJo.
- International experience is preferred.
- Experience in kidney research.

Experience and knowledge:

- Organized and methodical person, highly motivated and with initiative. Ability to work independently as well as in a team environment
- Technical knowledge on laboratory procedures related to tissue processing, flow cytometry and microscopy.
- Good communication skills and fluency in spoken and written English.
