Education and qualifications:

Required:

- *Medical Degree and residency in Neurology completed by the Spanish Minister of Health program (mandatory)*
- *Interest and previous training in clinical practice and research in Dementias.*
- *Good communication skills and fluency in spoken and written English.*

Desired:

- Publication of papers, articles and presentations in national and international conferences will be positively evaluated.
- Knowledge of statistical packages such as SPSS, R and others are desirable.

Experience and knowledge:

Required:

- At least two years of experience working with SAP management program.



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- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.

Desired:

- Previous experience in research projects and clinical trials in AD as well as other dementias.
- Interest in pursuing a PhD in neuroscience.

Main responsibilities and duties:
