The Pneumology group is looking for a **DATA MANAGER** to work in the Lung transplantation and pulmonary hypertension unit. The group comprises clinicians and scientists being one of their main goals to bring the benefits of the scientific research undertaken to improve lung transplant, pulmonary hypertension and lymphangioleiomyomatosis patients' survival and to develop biomarkers for a personalized medicine in those fields.

The Lung transplant programme at the Hospital Universitari Vall d'Hebron is the oldest in Spain and one of the 10 most active in the world. In 2018, our center performed the record number of 104 lung transplants, a quarter of all those performed in Spain, and achieved highly satisfactory clinical results.

The group participates in many clinical trials and patients' registries. The candidate will be involved in the data collection from electronic medical records for registries and for research databases.
