- Ability to coordinate a research group
- Knowledge of HIV databases
- Training and experience in clinical trials and clinical research
- Experience in Research Institutions and/or in Project Management within biotech and/or scientific environments.

- Knowledge of the specific legislation for clinical trials and clinical research.

Desired:

Knowledge and experience on statistics and software (R, python, SQL, etc) will be positively valued

Main responsibilities and duties:

- Coordinating and handling all activities regarding clinical trials and research projects related to HIV/STI, COVID aand other infectious diseases
- Data management activities, data collection and data entry
- Quality control of cohort databases, answering queries
- Participation in the meetings and activities of the Research Group in HIV infection



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Labour conditions:

- Full-time/Part-time position: 40h/week.
