Infection and Immunity in the pediatric patient group

VHIR offers a vacant position for a Clinical Research Coordinator for the Infection and immunity in the pediatric patient group. This group is part of the Pediatric Infectious Diseases and Immunodeficiencies Unit created in 1996 as Pediatric Infectious Diseases Unit and consolidated in 2005 like a consulting unit in nosocomial and opportunistic infections in immunocompromised pediatric patients. It is currently pioneering in this field and its Master in Pediatric Infectious Diseases is the first in Europe in this discipline. Its research is mainly focused on severe bacterial, fungal and viral infections in immunocompromised pediatric patients, and reflects both the daily clinical practice and the recommended directives by the European and National institutions for the following five to ten years.
