Project summary:

La fragilidad en personas mayores, incrementa el riesgo de eventos negativos de salud. Su detección precoz, abordaje y manejo multidisciplinar, especialmente incorporando actividad física y una nutrición equilibrada, han demostrado ser eficaces para revertirla. En 2016 se inició en un Área Básica de Salud (ABS) de Barcelona, el programa de investigación-implementación +AGIL, basado en un abordaje integral y coordinado entre atención primaria, geriatría y agentes comunitarios a partir de una intervención individualizada para personas mayores frágiles de la comunidad. El impacto positivo de +AGIL sobre la fragilidad a 3 y 6 meses, incluso en personas con deterioro cognitivo, ha sentado las bases para iniciar la adaptación e implementación del programa, en tres nuevas ABS de la cuidad. Sin embargo, ya que las características urbanas del entorno pueden modificar los patrones de actividad física, debemos tener en cuenta el entorno social y físico de las personas. Es así que identificamos la importancia de la amabilidad urbana para poder mantener activa a la población mayor de Barcelona.

Nuestro objetivo es, definir y conceptualizar un índice para evaluar la amabilidad urbana hacia las personas mayores en áreas de Barcelona con diferentes niveles socioeconómicos. Para ello proponemos: 1) Definir y conceptualizar mediante técnicas de co-diseño participativo con los diferentes agentes implicados, un índice de amabilidad urbana hacia las personas mayores, 2) Evaluar la aplicabilidad y factibilidad de uso del índice desarrollado; 3) Desarrollar el mapa de amabilidad urbana de las ABS implicadas, mediante metodologías de cálculo espacial soportadas por código abierto y replicables, 4) Comparar los mapas de amabilidad urbana de cada área; 5) Difundir los resultados entre los agentes




