Competitive Research Area

VHIR is looking for an experienced **Director of the Competitive Research Area**. The Competitive Research Area embraces an international unit (composed of 16 professionals) and a national unit (composed of 14 professionals), and has the mission of attracting and managing competitive funds/resources, accompanying researchers throughout the whole process of competitive funding (pre- and post-award), and guaranteeing compliance with the projects' scientific and economic milestones, therefore, contributing to the VHIR's national and international positioning and the institutional strategy and sustainability.

In recent years, VHIR's activity in the Competitive Research Area has positioned the institution as an international referent centre. In 2022, a total of 111 national projects, 27 international projects and 75 competitive Human Resources grants were awarded to the VHIR and its researchers, increasing the number of active projects to more than 470. The Competitive Research Area also centralizes and coordinates the management of national and international projects creating new alliances and leveraging the existing ones such as the European University Hospital Alliance (EUHA), the European Infrastructure for Translational Medicine (EATRIS) and the European Clinical Research Infrastructure (ECRIN) amongst others.

The selected candidate will be responsible for the management of this Area, actively contributing to positioning the Institute as a world referent in Biomedical Research.


Education and qualifications:

Experience and knowledge:


- Minimum of 7 years' experience working in project management within the scientific and biotechnological environment

- Design and plan the Area's objectives, monitoring its activity and directly reporting to the executive board.





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
- Lead, coordinate and supervise the National and International projects' units.
