- Familiarity with licensing agreements and revenue recognition principles.

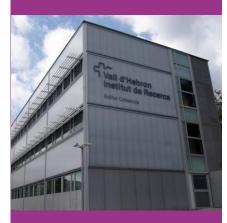
Main responsibilities and duties:
