

- Support researchers during proposal preparation and provide assistance in the project plan preparation
- Contribute to consortium building: search and select strategic partners
- Participate in the preparation of international competitive research proposals (writing and review)
- Attendance at events to establish new collaborations and contacts
- Any other duties related to the job as requested to contribute to the general functioning of the International Project Office.
