VHIR is looking for an experienced **Business Development Team Leader**. The Business Development team is composed of 4 experts with the mission of transforming excellence in Business Development and Technology Transfer reporting directly to the innovation and Business Development Director.

In recent years, VHIR has developed a **new innovation and business development model** that has enabled to accelerate the translation of research findings into clinical practice. The principles of this model are the foundation of VHIR's approach to innovation and technology transfer: **collaboration, entrepreneurship, and impact**. As a result, in the last years 13 technologies have been licensed, and 11 new spin-offs and start-ups have been created, which have generated more than 60 jobs, raised more than 62M€ investment and over 20M€ in competitive funds, and have a market value of +450M€.

To consolidate public-private relationships, **the new VHIR building** (to be finished in June 2024) will have 800 m2 exclusively **dedicated to create an Innovation Hub**. This space is designed as **a place for co-creation where researchers and companies can work closely together**, in a real clinical and academic environment, with the aim of transforming the collaboration model and bringing industry and research even closer together.





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
