Vall d'Hebron Research Institute (VHIR) is a public sector institution located in Barcelona (Spain) that promotes and undertakes innovative biomedical research at the University Hospital Vall d'Hebron. VHIR is focused on finding solutions to the health problems of citizens, and aims to contribute to scientific, educational, social and economic development within its specialist fields around the world.

Neurovascular diseases group objectives are to investigate the causes of stroke and dementia (vascular, primary neurodegenerative and multiple cause), and develop new therapies for these diseases, whose health impact is very high, given its high prevalence and years of life lost associated with disability. Our research is built around the identification of new therapeutic targets for neuroprotection and neurorepair, the identification of diagnostic and prognostic biomarkers in both biological fluids and neuroimaging and the study of the mechanisms of neuronal and vascular damage, in preclinical models of stroke, cerebral amyloidosis and Alzheimer's disease. We participate in clinical trials in Alzheimer's and other neurodegenerative diseases.






