- Master's degree related to Translational Research, or equivalent.
- Fluency in Catalan, Spanish and English.

- At least 4 years of experience working in a translational research group.
- Knowledge and experience in proteomics and data analysis pipelines (Mass Spectrometry).
- Pro-active attitude, ability to work independently and in a multidisciplinary team environment, analytical and critical thinking.

Desired:

- Knowledge on microscopy techniques and pathological assessment of gynecological tissues.
- Strong background in molecular biology and tissue culture techniques. Expertise in functional studies (migration, invasion, viability assays, etc.).

Main responsibilities and duties:
