
Project summary:

Older people with cancer urgently require personalized treatments. The reasons include the rapid increase in cancer and its consequences in an aging population and the difficult decision-making in older patients, for the following reasons:

- The diversity that characterizes them (multiple diseases, other problems and needs).

- The exclusion of the elderly from many cancer studies.

Frailty represents a state of vulnerability related to the addition of illnesses or difficulties in daily activities, which can also be detected by measuring whether people walk slower or have less strength or balance. Two people of the same age can have very different degrees of fragility or be more or less robust or vulnerable to diseases or treatments. Therefore, measuring frailty could be useful when considering a new treatment: in more fragile people, the damage could outweigh the benefits when applying certain invasive or demanding treatments; On the other hand, in less fragile people, but who could benefit from cancer treatments, individualized programs, with adapted physical exercise and a healthy diet, could help maintain good physical condition and reduce complications.






