## **Nephrology and Transplantation Research Group**

VHIR offers a vacant position for a post-doctoral researcher with immunological background for the Nephrology and Transplantation Research Group and related to the AGORA EraPermed grant.

AGORA introduces non-invasive biomarkers for predicting subclinical rejection and graft failure. The project aims to establish a comprehensive clinical decision tool through retrospective validation and a multicenter trial, AGORAC. This trial compares immunosuppression strategies, enhancing patient involvement and clinical efficiency. With validated biomarkers and collaborative expertise, AGORA promises to revolutionize kidney transplant care by personalizing immunosuppressive therapy on a European scale.




- Previous experience and participation in European multicenter studies in the field of Transplantation.


