The Melanoma Biomedical Research and Mouse Model and Cancer Laboratory at VHIR is currently seeking a candidate to apply pre-doctoral position. We offer advanced, interdisciplinary training in the field of cancer and tumor biology, and a lively and international educational atmosphere, with excellent state-of-the-art laboratory facilities and competitive fellowships. Our research is focused in translational investigations in melanoma and other skin cancers. We combine conventional and state of the art technologies (–omic tools) together with animal models and primary human tumor samples (PDX), to study cancer (melanoma) development and progression. Our main interest is to translate our results into clinic.

Specifically, the candidate will be involve studying the role of certain molecules in melanoma development and progression, and in the regulation of the immune system in the tumor environment with therapeutic purposes. More information about our group can be found here:
