VHIR offer 2 vacancies positions for the Paediatric Haematology and Oncology Division of Vall d'Hebron Hospital treats around 120 children and adolescents with cancer per year as well as up to 500 new patients with haematological conditions and performs 40-50 stem cell transplantations. All research is conducted through the Childhood Cancer and Blood Disorders Research Group of VHIR. There are 30 phase 1/2 and 15 phase 3/4 clinical trials ongoing and several patient registries. The candidate will join a very active team of 14 paediatric haematology and oncology consultants, 2 study coordinators, 1 data manager and 2 research nurses, and be involved in the day-to-day conduct of clinical trials and patient registries.
