Required:

Experience and knowledge:

Required:

- Experience in Maxipreps and minipreps as well as in other molecular biology techniques.
- At least 1 year of experience in AAV production and purification as well as in culture of stable human cell lines.

Main responsibilities and duties:

- Amplification and purification of plasmids (minipreps, maxipreps)
- Production of AAV vectors and passage of stable cell lines
- Maintenance of equipments
- Preparation of reagent stocks and materials
